

Health Care Administration Graduate Certificate

The Health Care Administration certificate is for health care professionals who aspire to be at the central point of control. The mix of finance, economics and managerial courses coupled with healthcare topics arm health care professionals with skills needed to lead, manage and administer a health care system, hospital or hospital network.

Curriculum

The Health Care Administration is an inter-disciplinary certificate jointly delivered by UC's College of Allied Health Sciences and the Lindner College of Business and includes two core courses (6 semester credits) and two elective courses (6 semester credits), depending on program affiliation and prior background.
