Community Health Worker

Conduct outreach for medical personnel or health organizations to promote, maintain, and improve individual and community health.



Healthcare Administrator

Manage the client and patient care experience. They also manage health informatics, including recordkeeping, hiring policies, performance reviews, and the overall financial health of a organization or department.



Health Educator

Educate people about the availability of healthcare services and teach people about behaviors that promote wellness. They implement wellness strategies by collecting data and discussing health concerns with members of specific populations.

Biostatistics

Use statistical reasoning and methods to address major problems in public health. Students who concentrate in biostatistics are interested in how data, population studies, and health intersect.



Environmental Public Health

Focuses on protecting people from threats to their health and safety posed by their environments. It requires an understanding of basic human needs and how the environment can affect them.



Epidemiology

Investigate patterns and causes of disease. They seek to reduce the risk and occurrence of negative health outcomes through research, community education and health policy.
